Community Outreach	Make contact with a sustainable community group (arrange a talk, attend an event)	Set up/partake in a sustainable community project in or around the UEA/Norwich area	Gain sponsorship / funding / create long-term partnership with a local sustainable group.
Participation in Sustainability Training	have a member of committee participate in sustainability training	have three members of committee participate in sustainability training, including one of your signatories	have approximately 75% of your committee participate in the training, including all of your signatories
Recording initiatives towards club travel	Record club emissions using the mileage tracker on the uea+sport budget document and offset 50% of club emissions	Offset 100% of club emissions, including individual travel to training/fixtures etc.	Evidence that the club are not only offsetting emissions, but actually reducing emissions as a whole (more cycling to training/matches, more car shares if cars are needed, etc.)
Kit/Equipment	1 example of kit being repaired instead of purchasing new kit OR 25% of kit is bought via sustainable methods where possible, sort through current equipment and donate any to local clubs/schools/charitys that isn't used	2 examples of kit being repaired instead of purchasing new kit OR 50% of new kit is bought via sustainable methods, recommend kit/equipment is repaired or given away sustainably	3 examples of kit being repaired instead of purchasing new kit OR 100% of kit is bought via sustainable methods
Hosting/participating in a campaign	Support another clubs sustainable campaign (e.g. attend their beach clean) support/attend an event happening during sustainability week/month (?)	Run a Sustainable campaign (e.g. campus and surrounding area clean)	Collaborate with a local charity in the field of sustainability on a campaign, Club runs multiple campighns throughout the year
Initiatives around events	Demonstrate sustainability planning and action for event	Demonstrate significant sustainability planning and action for event	Demonstrate high sustainability planning and action for event
Waste	encourage members on how to be sustainable e.g walk to sessions, reusable water bottles, recycled clothing material/towels - evie (in the form of social media posts?)	committee taking the lead on reducing waste at the club - eg them and their water bottle, why its helpful for the environment and what makes it convenient for them	demonstrating your club taking sustainable initiatives on waste, eg competition teams with all reusable bottles / packed lunches instead of single use plastics / meal deals etc
Club operations	Sustainability pledge included in club code of practice and sustainable goals set in club development plan	Evidence of at least one of their sustainable goals completed, and have a committee member who is responsible for sustainability of the club	Evidence that multiple club sustainable goals have been achieved and the impact of at least one of those is high e.g. equipment recycling scheme vs switching lights off
Food education	-educate members on food waste and how this can be reduced - specifically relating to your members -Educate members on the sustainability of your food (meals with lower carbon footprint/educational posts on Meat vs dairy vs veggie etc).	Show that the sustainability of food options have been considered for trips and events e.g. Christmas/Summer balls, weekend trips (more veggie options than Meat for example or less red Meat etc)	organise an event/participation week for memembs relating to food wast e.g. food bank, trying to live below the poverty line for a week, putting all your waste into one jar for a week/ meat free month/week/mondays
Socials (costumes, drink cotainers etc)	Show how sustainabilty has featured as part of the social planning (e.g., recycling)	If themed - show how sustainability has been take into account during costume design. If not themed - show how sustainability has featured in the planning of food and drinks	Plan a social dedicated/themed to sustainability
Moves	Get majority of members to join their club group on UEA Moves	Get your club to partake in a UEA Moves challenge relating specifically to sustainability	As a club, set up your own UEA Moves challenge relating to the environment?
Biodiversity	Raise awareness of biodiversity loss and how sport impacts this	"Leave no trace" rule adopted at all club activity i.e. no litter left behind, no spillages	Improve biodiversity net gain through a physical project or fundraiser
Tour	Show has sustainability has featured in the planning of your tour/main trips	Carry out a sustainable activity as a club on tour/main trips	Use a sustainable tour company or sustainable package as part of your tour/main trips
