Welcome to rugby at UEA! Become part of a fantastic programme and find your new family at university.

Both clubs offer a friendly and safe environment in which advanced players can further develop their skills playing at a high level, and less experienced players are able to learn the trade or strive for more competitive rugby.

Both clubs train regularly on campus, including video analysis, strength and conditioning, and match run through sessions. There are local playing opportunities as well as the opportunity to play at home and away against other Universities.

During the summer season both clubs participate in a series of sevens competitions, including Bournemouth, Oddballs and BUCS sevens. There is also a chance to represent UEA in our annual varsity competition against the University of Essex. There are many other social occasions for members including sports Tour and the club's annual Potters' Cup Competition.







COMPETITIVE RUGBY

Our Men's First Team compete in Tier 2 of British University and Colleges Sport (BUCS), and our Second and Third team in Tier 3 and 4 respectively. There are also opportunities to play in the local league with UEA Trojans or with partner club North Walsham RFC. Players may also represent Walsham Vikings (First team) in Regional 1 South East of the London & SE Division
