WHY NOW?

- You're 'in the groove' of studying
- There could be a reduction in fees if you stay at the same institution
- (at UEA all self-funding alumni qualify for 10% reduction, if you go straight onto postgraduate study after 1st this is 30%)
- If you stay at UEA it's familiar, housing issues may be easy to sort etc

WHY LATER?

- Work experience ñ take time to decide on your subject area
- Can save to pay for a Masters course
- Employer may pay for Masters course, if it benefits them, e.g. Unlocked Graduate Scheme





MASTERS: THE BASICS

What is a Masters?

- Taught Programme (MA/MSc) - modules 2/3 + dissertation 1/3
- Research Programme (MRes / MPhil) - modules 1/3 + research 2/3
- Professional/Vocational (e.g. MBA)
- 1yr (12 months) academic study FT
- 2yrs (24 months) PT - Sept-Aug
- Face2Face, Online, Blended
- 180 Credits (e.g. 4x30 credit modules + 1x60 credit dissertation)
- **Eligibility:** Varies, some 2.2, others 2:1 or higher at UG, IELTS 6.5



APPLICATION

- **Apply directly to your prospective university**
- **UCAS Postgraduate is a centralised application service - 12 institutions use UCAS Postgraduate for their Masters applications.**
- **Most universities ask for a 2:1, if you don't have this speak to admissions you may still be able to apply**
- **You can apply to more than one course**
- **There are no set deadlines, but popular courses will fill fast**
